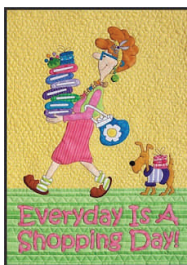


Saturday, July 14 choose one from:

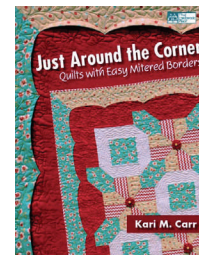


From book author and quilt instructor to pattern & notion developer, Kari's passion for quilting is obvious. There are always fresh ideas from this recycled Home-Ec teacher.
