Delivering Your Quilts to Perry

We will not be using pillow cases this year, bring your quilts in rolling suitcases, plastic bags, or whatever you wish. You will leave the quilts with us without any packaging. Hang clothing on a wire hanger and cover with a clear plastic bag. No black garbage bags, please! Make sure that your identification tag from your registration form is in a small plastic bag pinned or sewn to the back left lower corner of your garment or quilt. If it is somewhere else we may hang your quilt upside down! Be sure that the category and technique number show and your name is facing down. Be sure to cover your name and city on any labels. Drop off sites will be listed in the next newsletter.

IQG Logo Challenge Items

Challenge items will be judged with the rest of the quilts in their own category. Treat these entries the same as the rest of the entries.

To make sure we have all the quilts organized and ready to judge, we must have the quilts delivered in person between 9:00 and 11:00 a.m., July 11 or received in the mail or by UPS by July 7. If you hand deliver your quilt but want it shipped back to you, please include a shipping carton, shipping instructions, and a check for return postage and insurance.

Shipping Instructions

You may ship your quilts by US Mail or UPS to arrive by July 7, 2008 to:

When shipping your quilt please include shipping instructions, and a check for return postage and insurance. It is recommended that you pack your quilts in a plastic bag inside your shipping carton to protect them from moisture. Tape the carton closed securely. If you want notification that your quilts have arrived, please enclose a self addressed stamped postcard.

Quilt Take Down

Quilt take down will be from 5-6p.m. on Sat., July 19. You must be there during this time to take down your quilt unless you have made arrangements to have it shipped. You will accompany an IQG member to find your own quilts and take them down. Prepare accordingly with your own bags. You must pick up a number when you arrive for take down and they will be taken down in numerical order.
